# The Nataf3al Experience A Responsive and Adaptive Approach to Complex Needs

The Nataf3al project was a multi-year initiative, supported and funded by France via l'Agence Française de Développement (AFD), designed to support the retention of vulnerable children in Lebanese public schools. Nataf3al adopted a holistic approach, recognising that addressing student retention required a multi-faceted strategy that encompassed academic support, psychosocial well-being, teacher capacity building, community engagement, and the physical learning environment



#### **Objective 1: Supporting Student Retention Directly**

Targeted academic, psychosocial, and parental support to keep students in school






#### **Objective 2: Strengthening Teacher Capacity**

Equipping teachers to foster social cohesion, active learning, and student wellbeing






#### Objective 3: Increasing Access to School and Enhancing Social Cohesion

Improving school access and environments through rehabilitation, and promoting social cohesion through community-led initiatives and engagement




#### **Objective 4: Learning for Capitalization Modeling**
